

List of the applicable international testing standards for Protective Headgear

“Protective headgear” is defined in the FEI General Regulations as “appropriate helmet or headgear that is in compliance with the applicable international testing standards”, with reference to the present list of standards.

- British standard PAS 015 (1998 onwards) provided they are BSI Kitemarked
- European standard VG01.040 2014-12, with BSI Kitemark or Inspec IC mark
- Australian standard AS/NZ 3838 (2006 onwards) provided they are SAI global marked
- Australian standard ARB HS 2012 provided they are SAI global marked
- American ASTM F1163: 2004a onwards, with SEI mark or Snell E2001 or 2016

To verify that their protective headgear complies with the above, athletes can look for the standard/specification and mark inside the product.
